Payment Schedule

To help us plan the season and secure your spot, payments are split into two installments:

What to Expect: A Season of Flavor: Eating with the seasons is a journey! Your CSA box will evolve as the weather changes, moving from the crisp greens of spring to the hearty harvests of autumn. Each box will contain 6-9 different items.

- **Early Season:** Boxes feature fresh greens, crisp radishes, and fragrant herbs.
- **Summer Staples:** Peak season brings favorites like sun-ripened tomatoes, cucumbers, and green beans.
- **Fall Bounty:** We wrap up the year with winter squash, broccoli, cabbage, and more.

The Early Season Bonus: To ensure you get the best value while the summer crops are still maturing, early-season shares will be supplemented with premium local goods, including our signature **Black Garlic** and seasonings, local maple syrup, honey, and fresh farm eggs. Each box is curated to ensure the retail value of the product exceeds your weekly cost.

- **Flash Sales:** Keep an eye out! When the garden overflows, we'll offer exclusive flash sales on bulk items like tomatoes, beans and cucumbers.

Customized for You: I want you to love everything in your box!

- **The "No-Go" List:** If there is a specific vegetable you absolutely oppose, please email me. I am happy to provide a substitute.
- **Try Something New:** For those unique veggies you might be unfamiliar with, I'll include **simple recipes** to make preparation easy and delicious to help you make the most of every item in your box.

Pick-Up Details:

- **When:** Tuesdays or Fridays, 4:00 PM – 6:00 PM.
- **Where:** **Hummingbird Farm MN, 18254 610th Ave., Litchfield.** 9 miles south of Litchfield, 15 miles northwest of Hutchinson.
- **Home Delivery:** If you prefer your box delivered to your home or work, there is a fee of \$5 per box/per week for local delivery. Day and time will be between Tuesday and Thursday, balancing harvesting and workload.
- **Vacation or week off:** If you're going to be gone on vacation, etc. you have a few options
 - You can skip the box, and I'll add to your box up during other weeks,
 - You can give the food box to a friend or family member
 - Pick the box up on your way out of town.
 - **I can't offer refunds for missed weeks.**
- **Special Request:** Children are welcome, but please leave the dog(s) in the car for the safety of all. This is a working farm. *Thank you for your understanding.*
